

RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICES;
3 AMENDING SECTION 38.19 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
4 ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF RAW
5 WATER SUPPLY LARGE USER RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,
6 INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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8 WHEREAS, Broward County provides raw water supply to large users of the
9 County's Regional Raw Water System pursuant to certain large user agreements (the
10 "Agreements");

11 WHEREAS, the Agreements require that Broward County review the rates on an
12 annual basis, and Broward County has completed its annual review accordingly;

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
14 the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be established
15 following public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been satisfied; and

16 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the
17 best interest of the public to revise Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative
18 Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for large users of the Regional Raw
19 Water System effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, 2025, NOW,
20 THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
amended to read as follows:

38.19. Raw Water Supply Large User Rates.

The following schedule of rates, fees, and charges for Large Users of the Regional
Raw Water System operated by Broward County Water and Wastewater Services is
effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, ~~2024~~ 2025:

a.	Customer Charge (per account, per month)	\$5.44	<u>\$5.49</u>
b.	Operations and Maintenance (per one thousand (1,000) gallons).....	\$0.280	<u>\$0.266</u>
c.	Monthly Improvement, Repair, and Replacement Surcharge (all charges).....		10%

Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to
be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity
of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this
Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any
individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the
applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,
property, or circumstance.

Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such intention.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Administrative Code Resolution is effective upon adoption.
