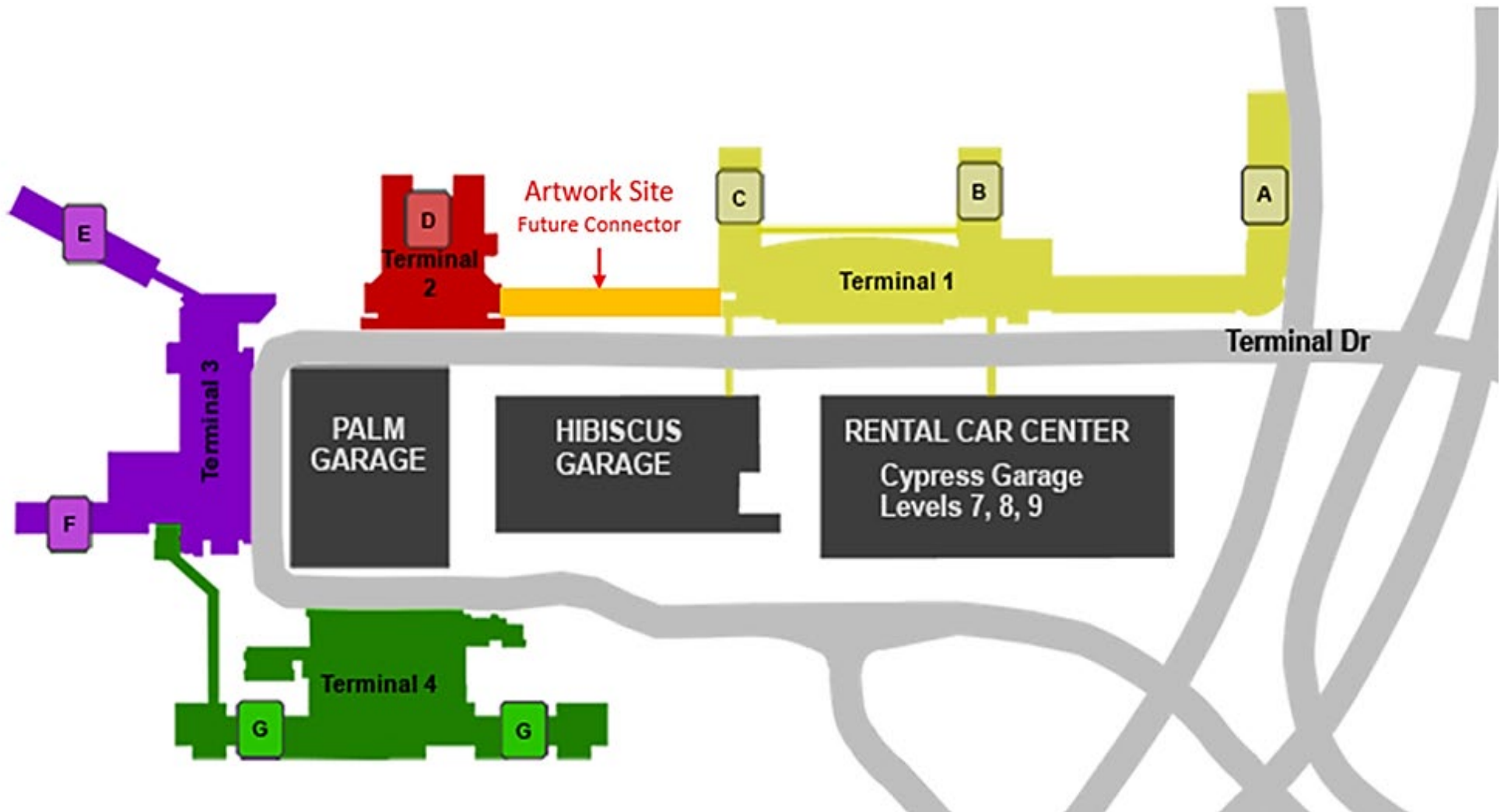

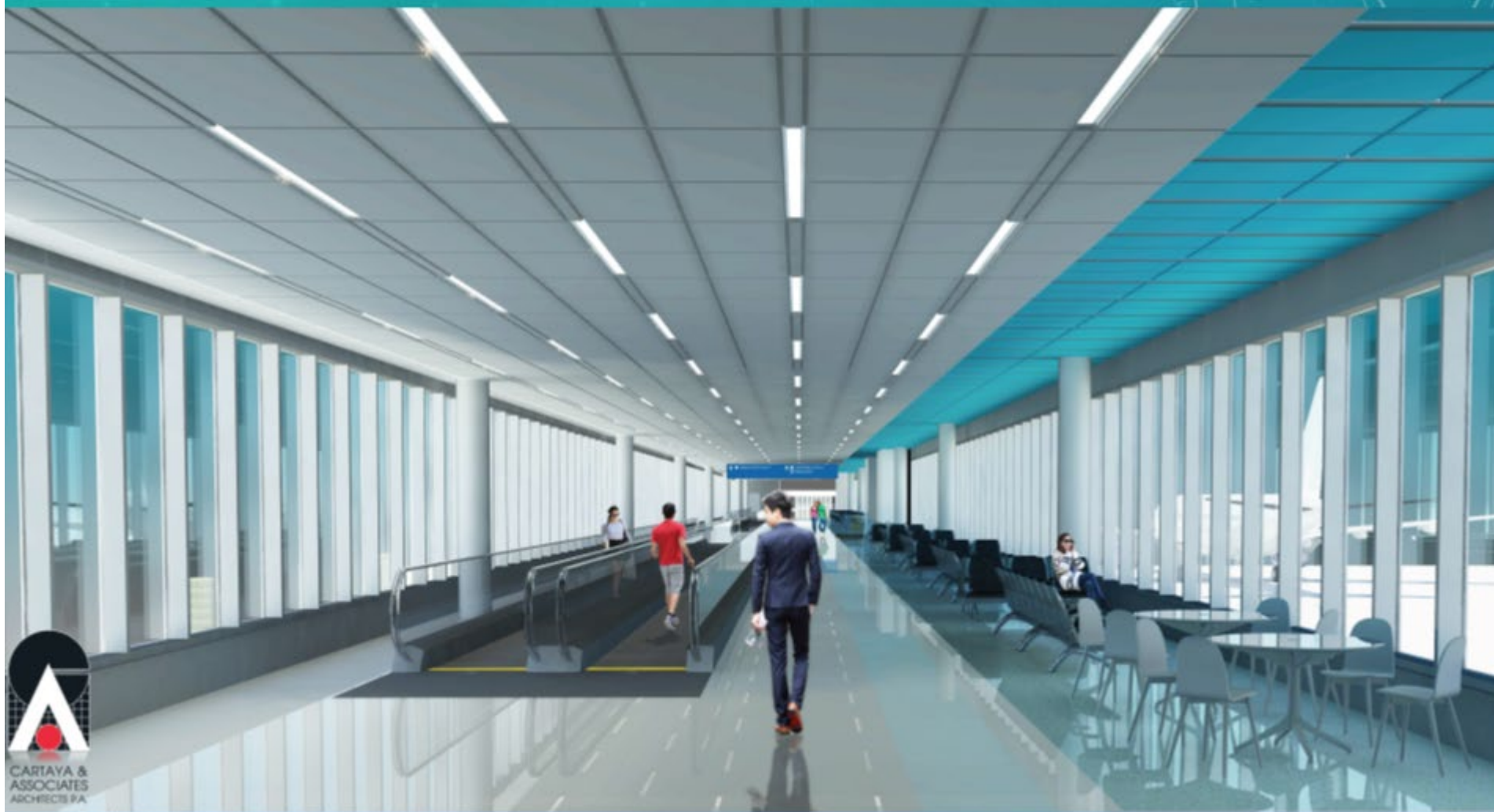

CONCEPT

Inspired by Fort Lauderdale’s maritime heritage and the vibrant ecosystems of its surrounding waters, this installation transforms the airport connector into an immersive aquatic journey. The long walls of windows already evoke an aquarium-like atmosphere; suspended overhead, more than one hundred model boats and ships extend that sensation, forming a dazzling current of color and motion.

The fleet drifts like a school of fish, bridging two worlds: the city’s legacy of boating, trade, and exploration, and the natural marine life that defines its coastlines. As travelers move through the corridor, they experience a fluid, dreamlike passage that celebrates both human ingenuity and the rhythms of the sea. The work invites reflection on Fort Lauderdale’s identity—where waterways, history, and nature converge in a shared voyage.

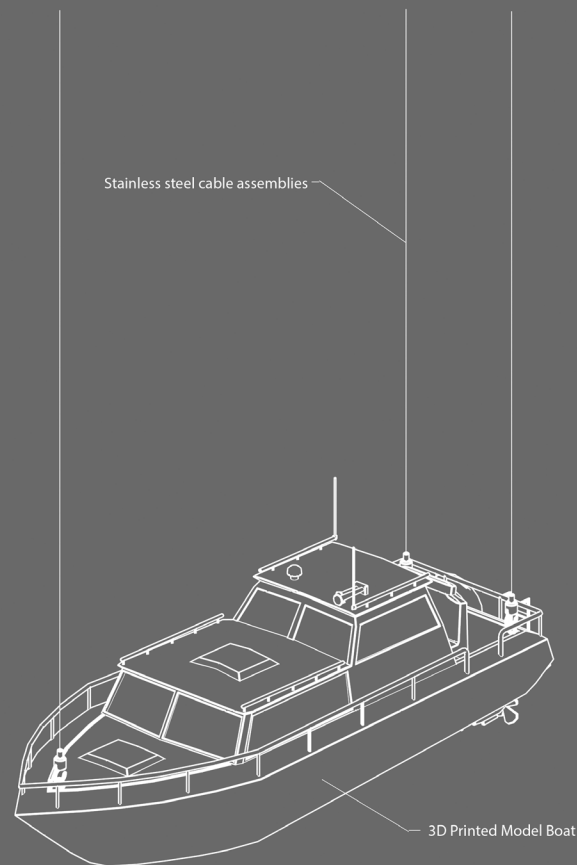
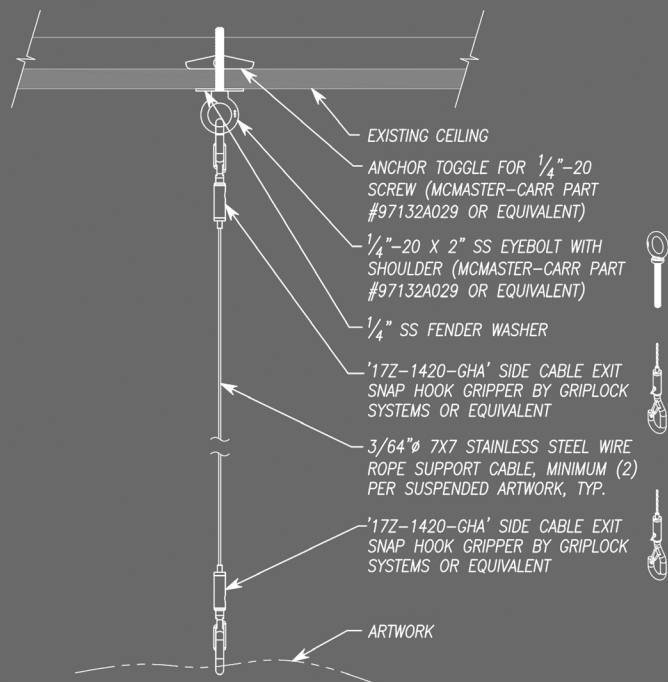
