1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, NAMING A COURTROOM AT THE BROWARD COUNTY
3 JUDICIAL COMPLEX AS THE “_____ COURTROOM”;
4 DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY
5 TO EFFECTUATE THE NAMING OF THE COURTROOM; AND PROVIDING FOR
6 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 WHEREAS, the Broward County Commission (“Commission”) has, on occasion,
10 recognized the significant contributions of Broward County Judges and members of the
11 legal community who have performed exemplary service by honoring such individuals
12 through the naming of courtrooms, hearing rooms, or designated areas within the
13 Broward County Judicial Complex located at 201 Southeast Sixth Street, Fort Lauderdale,
14 Florida, 33301 (the “Judicial Complex”);

15 WHEREAS, the naming of a courtroom is one of the highest honors Broward
16 County may bestow on a legal professional in recognition of that individual’s contribution
17 to Broward County and the State of Florida; and

18 WHEREAS, in recognition of _____’s significant contribution to
19 Broward County and the State of Florida, the Commission desires to designate a
20 courtroom as the “_____ Courtroom,” NOW, THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
22 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

23 Section 1. The Commission hereby names Courtroom 5165 as the
24 “_____ Courtroom.”

25 Section 2. The Commission hereby directs the County Administrator to take all
26 administrative actions necessary to implement this Resolution.

27 Section 3. Severability.

28 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
29 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
30 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
31 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
32 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
33 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

34 Section 4. Effective Date.

35 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
