1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO PORT EVERGLADES FOREIGN-TRADE ZONE
3 NO. 25, TARIFF NO. 5 ("TARIFF"); AMENDING SECTION 42.29 OF THE BROWARD
4 COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"); AMENDING FTZ
5 OPERATOR FEES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE
6 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
9 ("Board"), desires to amend Section 42.29 of the Broward County Administrative Code,
10 Exhibit 42.B, to revise Foreign-Trade Zone No. 25, Tariff No. 5, regarding FTZ Operator
11 Fees; and

12 WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the revisions are necessary and in the
13 best interests of Broward County, NOW, THEREFORE,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
15 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

16 Section 1. Foreign-Trade Zone No. 25, Tariff No. 5, as set forth in Section
17 42.29 and Exhibit 42.B of the Broward County Administrative Code, is hereby
18 amended in relevant part as follows:

19 . . .

Item No. 407—FTZ Operator and Subzone Operator Fees.

FTZ Operators and Subzone Operators shall be charged fees by Grantee as follows:

(a) FTZ Operator Fees:

Application Fee ~~\$5,150~~ 2,500

Annual Fee (no production) ~~\$12,360~~ 7,000

Annual Fee (with production) ~~\$30,385~~ 9,000

Activation Fee ~~\$5,150~~ 4,000

Production Authorization Request Fee \$5,150 per request

Alteration Request Fee \$3,090 per request

. . .

Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be

renumbered or relettered and the word “resolution” may be changed to “section,” “article,” or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish such intention.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Administrative Code Resolution is effective upon adoption.
