2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE JULY 2026 BROWARD COUNTY RESILIENCE
3 PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 WHEREAS, the 2025 Broward County Resilience Plan was developed pursuant to
7 a professional services agreement with Hazen & Sawyer, P.C., and subsequent changes
8 in applicable law necessitated review prior to approval of the plan by the Board of County
9 Commissioners ("Commission"); and

10 WHEREAS, such review and editing resulting from such review have occurred,
11 NOW, THEREFORE,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
13 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

14 Section 1. The Commission hereby approves the July 2026 Broward County
15 Resilience Plan ("Plan"), subject to Sections 2 and 3 of this Resolution.

16 Section 2. The Commission has been advised and finds that the Plan is
17 consistent with applicable law as of the effective date of this resolution and resolves that
18 any unidentified or inadvertent provisions of the Plan that are inconsistent with current
19 and future applicable law are deemed null and void and are stricken from the Plan without
20 further action by the Commission.

Section 3. The Commission's approval of the Plan and any strategy or actions to implement the Plan are subject to (a) future budgetary action by the Commission appropriating the necessary funds; and (b) any revisions to the Plan necessitated by future changes in applicable federal or Florida law.

Section 4. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
