Campground Sites

Create designated sites within our County campgrounds for overnight parking/safe zones to serve those who are facing homeless.

Stationery Locker Hubs

Install stationary lockers near shelters treatment centers, bus terminals, libraries and other County facilities.

Events

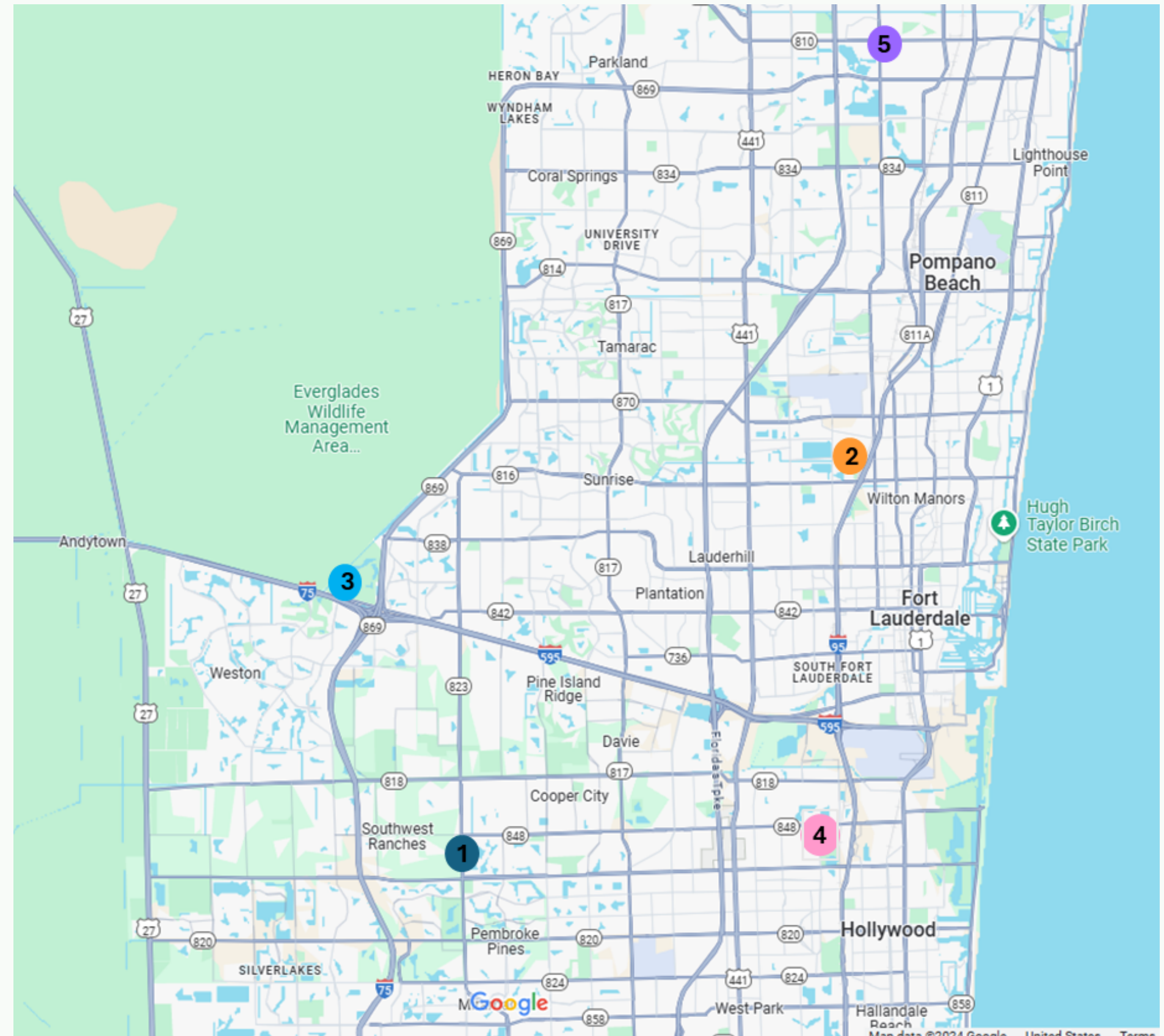
Create events specifically for the homeless (e.g, shuttle to local Career Fairs, opportunities to hear success stories of people who have walked their journey or addiction programs in Broward County like BARC, Calvary House,etc.

Letter of the Law on Public Sleeping

- **Broward County Ordinance 2024-37**
 - On October 1, 2024, the Florida Senate enacted a House Bill which prohibits counties and municipalites from authorizing or otherwise allowing public camping or sleeping on public property without certification of designated public property by DCF.
- **House Bill 1365 (HB 1365)**
 - Unauthorized Public Camping and Public Sleeping; Prohibits counties & municipalities from authorizing or otherwise allowing public camping or sleeping on public property without certification of designated public property by DCF; authorizes counties to designate public property for such uses for specified time period; requires counties to establish specified standards & procedures relating to such property; authorizes DCF to inspect such property & to issue notice; provides exception during specified emergencies.

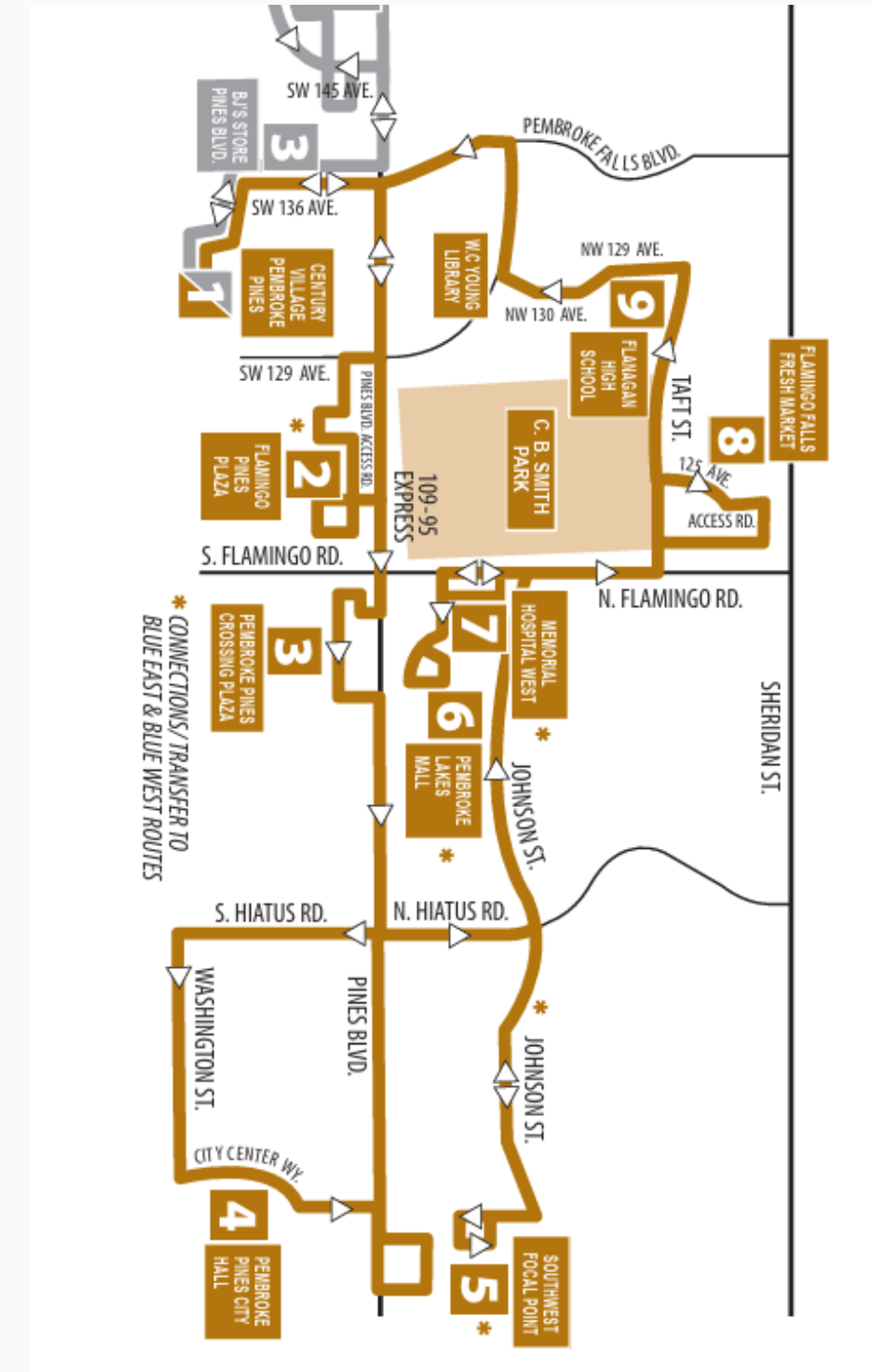

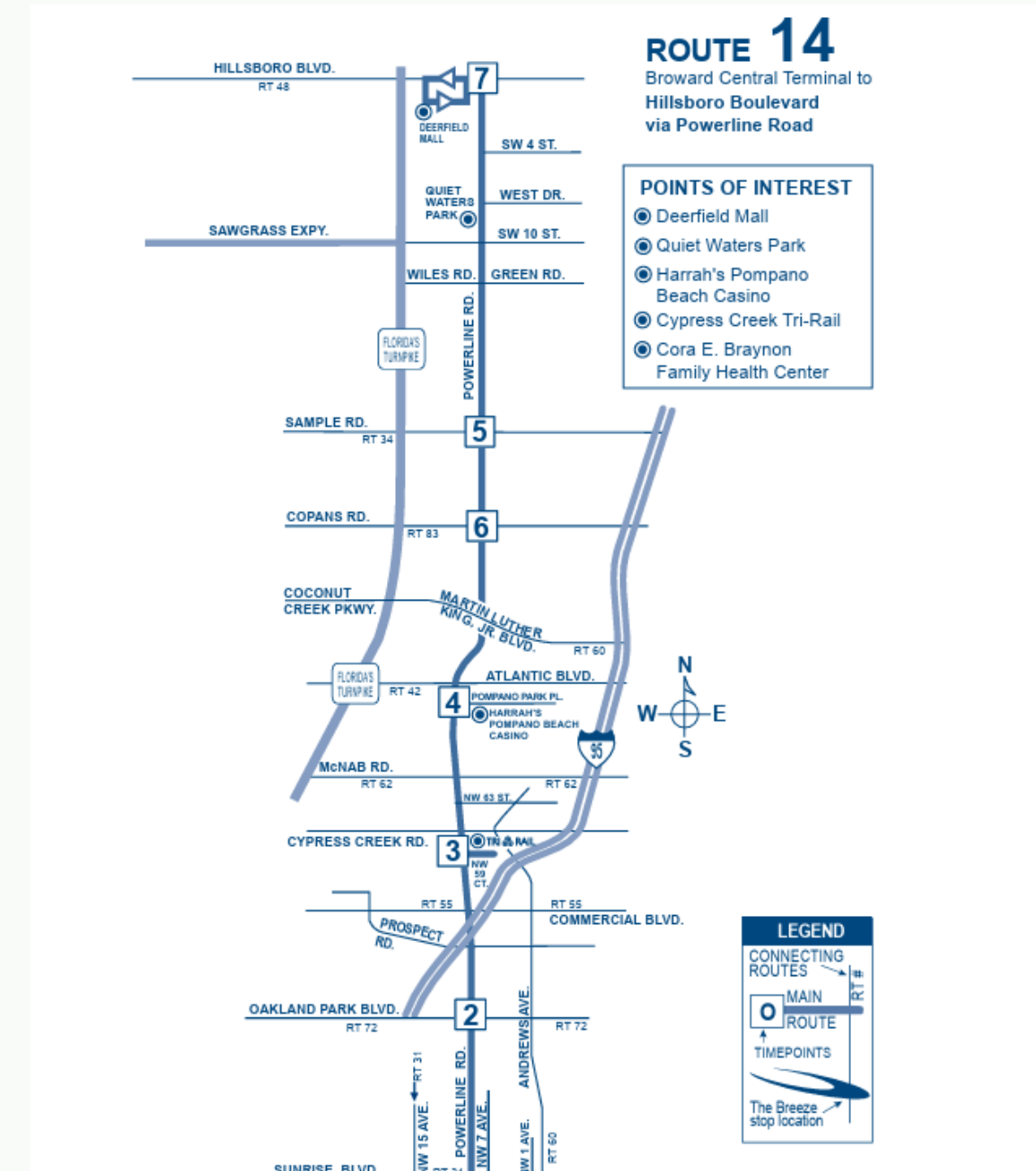
- Shuttle Bus Service (Gold Route)

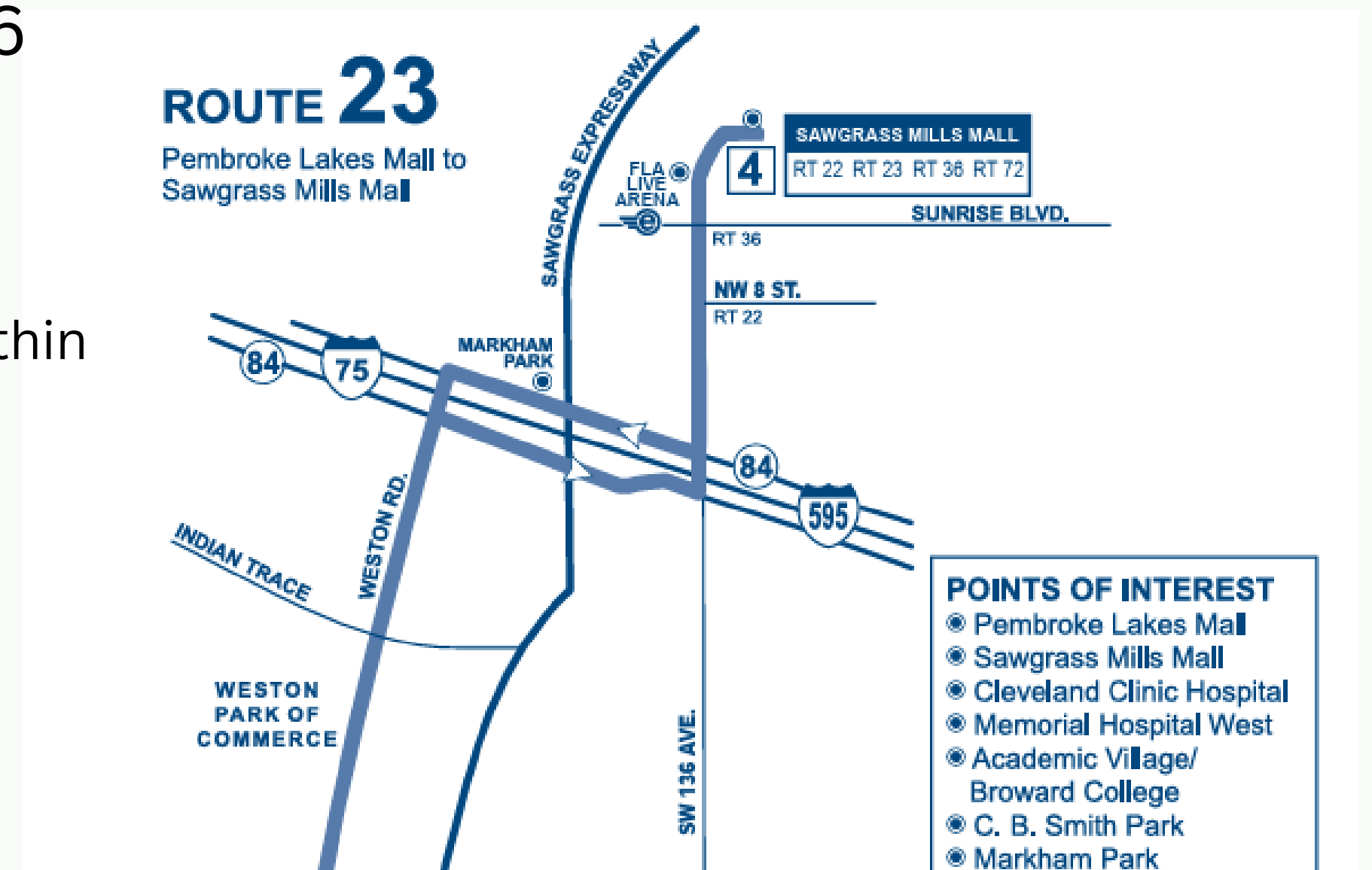
- Feeding South Florida operates 20 locations within a 3-4 mile radius

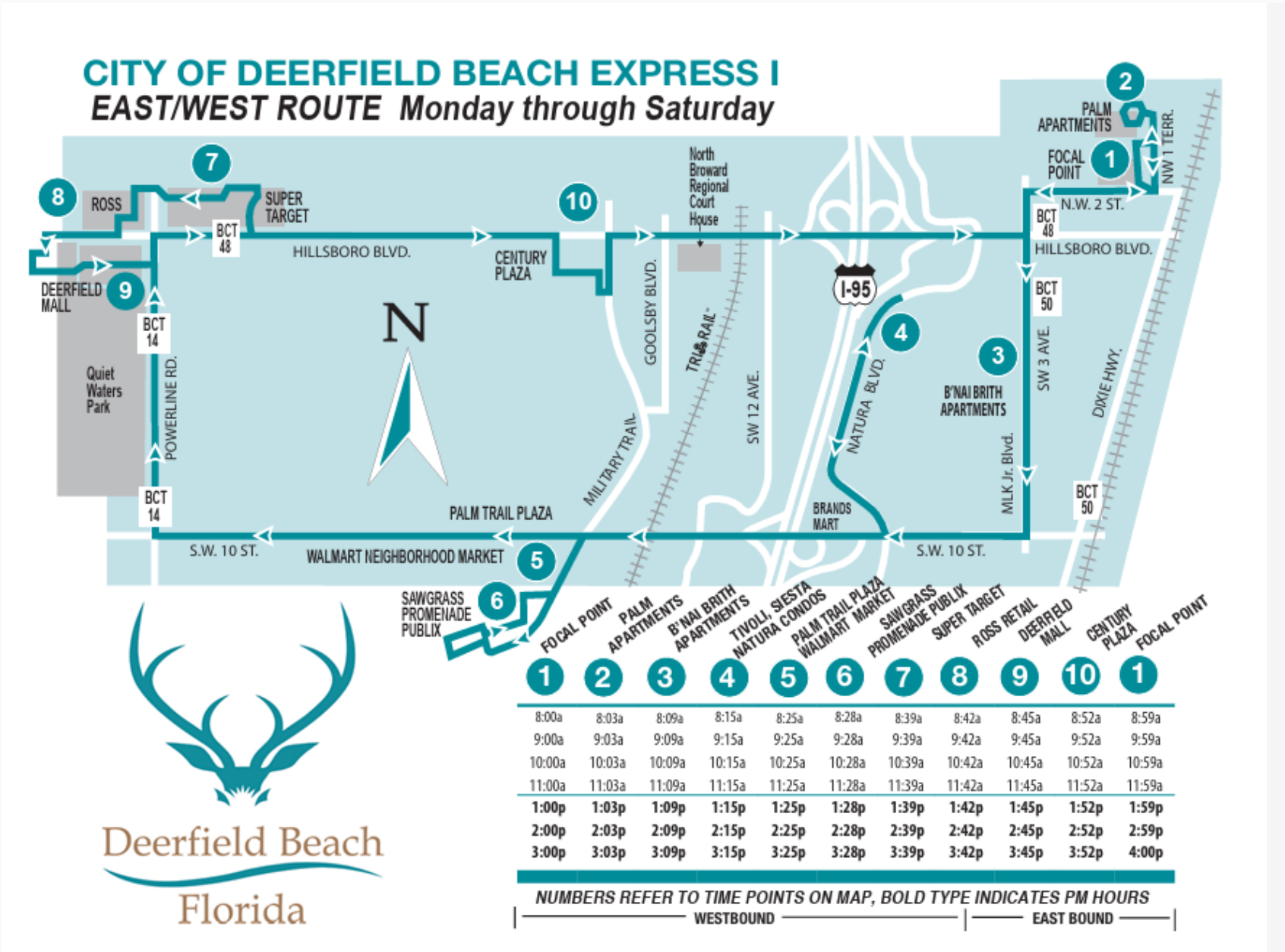
- BCT Route 23 (City Bus)

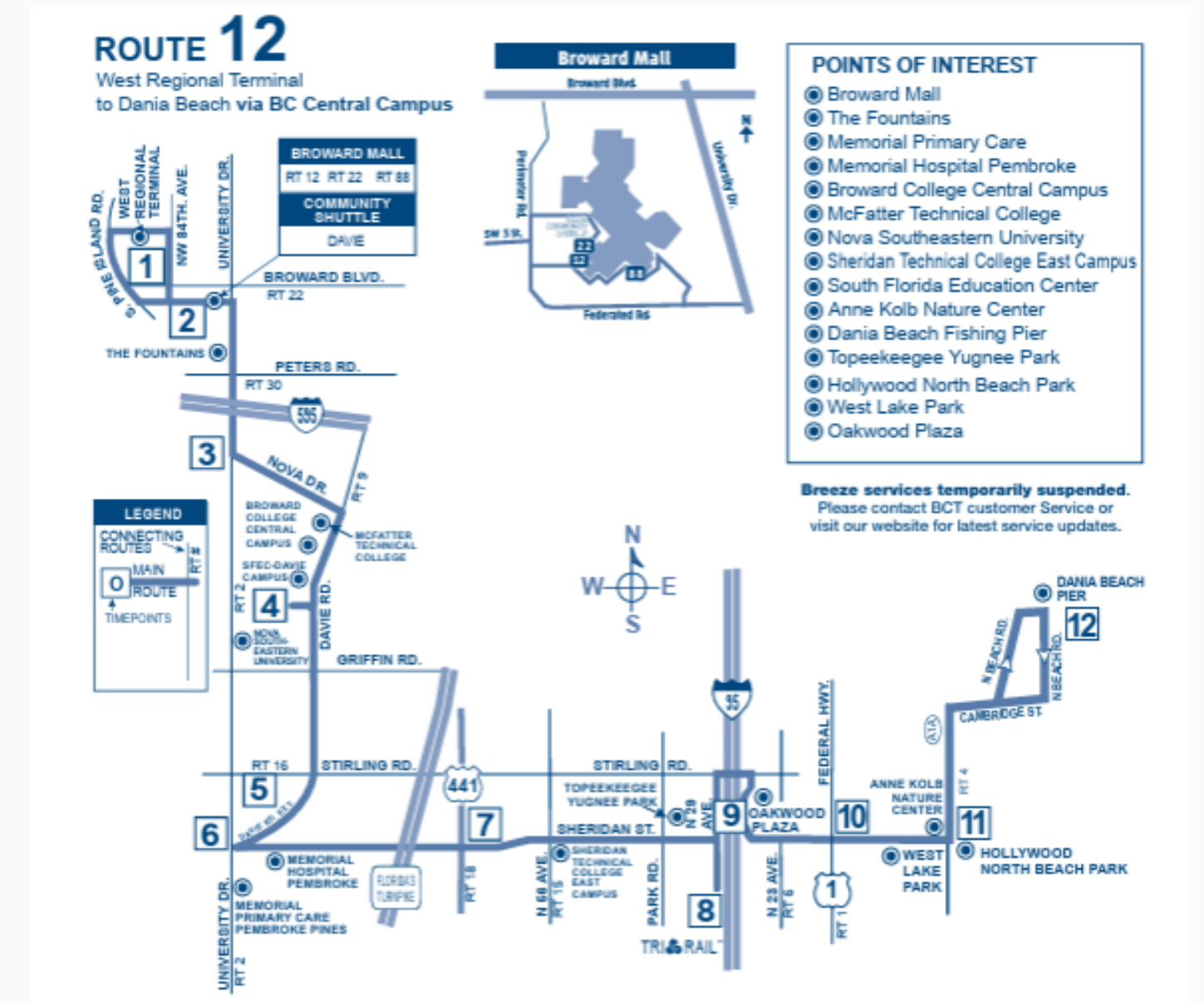
