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A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; APPROVING PROJECT SAWGRASS FOR A BROWARD COUNTY STRATEGIC JOB CREATION INCENTIVE PURSUANT TO SECTION 9½-52, BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF SIXTY-ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$61,600) FOR A STRATEGIC JOB CREATION INCENTIVE FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025 THROUGH 2031; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the corporation referred to as Project Sawgrass, for the purpose of this Resolution, has requested that Broward County maintain the confidentiality of its name and business information pursuant to Section 288.075, Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, Project Sawgrass, an international aviation company currently located in California and North Carolina, is considering locating a regional headquarters in the City of Miramar, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Project Sawgrass is requesting a Strategic Job Creation Incentive from Broward County pursuant to Section 9½-52, Broward County Code of Ordinances, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") hereby approves a Strategic Job Creation Incentive not to exceed a total amount of Sixtyone Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$61,600) for fiscal years 2025 through 2031, collectively, through Broward County's Strategic Job Creation Incentive Program, calculated on the basis of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700) per qualifying job.

Section 2. In furtherance of Project Sawgrass's request for approval, the Board has determined that the basis of this proposed project's private sector wage commitment calculation shall be one hundred fifteen percent (115%) of the average annual wage in Broward County.

Section 3. The amounts authorized herein shall constitute Broward County's total commitment to this project for participation in the Strategic Job Creation Incentive Program.

Section 4. The County Administrator is authorized to execute all necessary documents in connection with the award of the incentive, subject to review and approval for legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney, provided the County's total financial commitment does not exceed the maximum amount stated herein.

Section 5. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement and administer the incentive award.

Section 6. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such

determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
group, entity, property, or circumstance.
