AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ABOLISHING THE BROWARD COUNTY HEALTH FACILITIES AUTHORITY; REPEALING SECTIONS 15-173 THROUGH 15-194 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,

(Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners)

INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Health Facilities Authority ("Authority") is a public body corporate and politic created and existing under the laws and Constitution of the State of Florida, including Chapter 154, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to Ordinance No. 77-35, enacted by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") on July 6, 1977, as codified at Chapter 15, Article XII, Sections 15-173 through 15-194 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code");

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 154.209, Florida Statutes, the Authority's purpose is to assist health facilities with the acquisition, construction, financing, and refinancing of projects in Broward County primarily through the issuance of bonds;

WHEREAS, in the past decade, the Authority has received few requests for bond financing and has not issued new bonds;

WHEREAS, all of the Authority's outstanding bonds have matured, and the Authority has no current outstanding bonds;

21	WHEREAS, based on this lack of activity, on September 18, 2023, the governing
22	board of the Authority voted to request that the Board abolish the Authority;
23	WHEREAS, under Section 154.207, Florida Statutes, and Section 15-194 of the

WHEREAS, under Section 154.207, Florida Statutes, and Section 15-194 of the Code, the Board has the power and authority to abolish the Authority at any time by ordinance, provided all bond indebtedness incurred by the Authority has been paid; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined it is in the public interest to abolish the Authority and to repeal the sections of the Code pertaining to the Authority,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby abolishes the Authority and designates Broward County as the Authority's successor entity. The Authority and Broward County's staff are directed to take all budgetary and administrative actions necessary to effectuate same.

Section 2. Chapter 15, Article XII, and Sections 15-173 through 15-194 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, pertaining to the Authority, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such

determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such intention.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
