RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR AN \$85,000 GRANT
3 UNDER THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION
4 FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE WEST BROWARD BOAT
5 RAMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
6 EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Division is requesting authorization to
9 submit a grant application to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission
10 ("FWC") Florida Boating Improvement Program ("FBIP") for a grant in the amount of
11 Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000) (the "Grant") to be used for a project named the
12 West Broward Boat Ramp Replacement Project (the "Project");

13 WHEREAS, the Project includes the replacement of two existing boat ramps at
14 West Broward Boat Ramp, along with the installation of a new aluminum floating dock;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, if awarded, the Grant will be used for the design and permitting phase
17 of the Project, NOW, THEREFORE,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
19 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

20 Section 1. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board")
21 hereby authorizes the Director of the Parks and Recreation Division ("Director") to submit

an application for the Grant. The Board also authorizes the Director or the Director's written designee to serve as the County's official representative in connection with the application for the Grant and, if awarded, to administer the Grant on behalf of the County.

Section 2. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the County Administrator to take all administrative and budgetary actions necessary to implement this Resolution and, if awarded, the Grant.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
