Item 11, Revised Summary/Background Information:

Currently reads:

“Approval of this item would give rise to certain employment conflicts under Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes, which provides that “no public officer...shall have or hold any employment or contractual relationship with any business entity...which is...doing business with an agency of which he or she is an officer or employee.” In accordance with Section 112.313(12), Florida Statutes, Board approval is required to waive any conflict arising under Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes. An effective waiver requires a two-third vote from the Board to approve the Business Transaction, Relationship, or Interest - Form 4a, attached hereto as Exhibit No. 1, and constitutes full disclosure of any existing conflicts.”

Should read:

“Mr. Badore has served on the Small Business Development Advisory Board since his appointment in 2017. Mr. Badore is disclosing two contracts that Broward County recently awarded to his employer (detailed in Exhibit 1) thus requiring a conflict of interest waiver.

In accordance with 112.313(12), Florida Statutes, Commission approval is required to waive any conflict of interest arising under Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes. An effective waiver requires two-thirds vote of the Commission after disclosure of the conflicting relationship in accordance with Section 112.313(12), Florida Statutes. Form 4A, Disclosure of Business Transaction, Relationship, or Interest, is attached as Exhibit 1 and constitutes full disclosure of any existing conflict.

Approval of this item would waive certain employment conflicts under Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes, which provides that "no public officer... shall have or hold any employment or contractual relationship with any business entity... which is... doing business with an agency of which he or she is an officer or employee."
