"...In addition, if the proposed revisions to the Procurement Code are approved by the Board on June 13, the Purchasing Division will implement the new method of issuing RFPs, RLIs, and RFQs with an anticipated total value of more than \$500,000, which includes advance written notice to the Board and, absent objection by a County Commissioner within the five-day period following such notice, issuance of the solicitation without the need for formal Board approval.

Any airport items approved by the County Administrator or designee pursuant to this delegated authority that require specific Board approval under Section 332.0075, Florida Statutes, will be brought to the Board for ratification after the Summer Recess."
