9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
10	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:
11	Section 1. Section 5-182.2 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is
12	hereby amended to read as follows:
13	Sec. 5-182.2. Adequacy of Regional Road Network within Standard
14	Concurrency Districts.
15	(a) Regional Transportation Concurrency within Standard Concurrency
16	Districts. Before a development permit is approved for an application for property within
17	a Standard Concurrency District, which application is subject to an adequacy
18	determination according to Section 5-182.1(a)(4)a) of this article, one (1) of the following
19	findings shall be made:

21	(2) The proposed development places trips on, or creates, overcapacity links
22	within the impact area, but one (1) of the following conditions applies:
23	
24	g) De Minimis Exception: The proposed development meets all of the
25	following criteria:
26	1) The proposed development is one (1) consists of ten (10) o
27	<u>fewer</u> single family dwelling <u>s</u> or <u>one (1)</u> duplex.
28	
29	Section 2. Severability.
30	If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
31	portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
32	Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
33	legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
34	determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual
35	group, entity, property, or circumstance.
36	Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.
37	It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
38	Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective
39	date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word
40	"ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word o
41	phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such intention.

42 Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
