Piggyback on Martin County, Florida Contract No. RFB2022-3382

NO CBE GOAL

This memorandum supersedes the previous memorandum dated October 16, 2024.

Broward Addiction Recovery Division (BARC) is seeking the purchase and delivery of cleaning products and food products, not limited to but which may include, frozen food, beverages, canned goods, grocery staple items, and produce for BARC and various other Broward County agencies that may have a need for these goods and services. The Using Agency will be piggybacking on an existing Martin County, Florida contract, No. RFB2022-3382, under which these services will be provided by Cheney Brothers, Inc. Broward County's use of this contract will be authorized via a Participating Addendum.

Per Sec. 1-81.3(a) of the Business Opportunity Act, a CBE goal of 25% is established for each Broward County contract, barring the exceptions identified in this section, unless the Broward County Board of County Commissioners or the County Administrator approves a different goal or, based on a written determination from the Office of Economic and Small Business Development (OESBD), determines that no CBE goal shall be established. OESBD has determined that there are no subcontracting opportunities under this contract. Consequently, no CBE goal is being recommended. This assessment is made based upon an examination of the Request for Goal Assignment Form, and accompanying support documentation, as submitted to OESBD by the Using Agency.

Eligibility for the CBE Program is based on economic/size standards; the program does not utilize race or gender criteria for either certification or goal methodology purposes. If you have any concerns regarding available subcontracting opportunities, please contact our office at (954) 357-6400.
