## ORDINANCE NO.

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD 2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING DIVISION 4 OF CHAPTER 1, "PROCUREMENT 3 FROM BUSINESSES WITH DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE PROGRAM." INCLUDING 4 SECTIONS 1-71 THROUGH 1-73 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF 5 ORDINANCES ("CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE 6 CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 (Sponsored by the Board of County Commissioners) 8 9 WHEREAS, Sections 1-71 through 1-73 of the Broward County Code of 10 Ordinances, enacted in 1992, codify a policy of requiring County contracts be awarded to 11 vendors with a drug-free workplace policy, and generally restate Florida law as set forth 12 in Section 287.087, Florida Statutes; 13 WHEREAS, the Broward County Procurement Code also includes a reference to 14 the policy of awarding County contracts to vendors with a drug-free workplace policy; and 15 WHEREAS, to ensure continued consistency with Florida law, the Board of County 16 Commissioners finds it appropriate at this time to repeal the codification of Florida law in 17 the Code and to consolidate the preference for vendors with drug-free workplace 18 programs in a single location in the Broward County Procurement Code, which will be 19 done by separate Resolution, 20 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

21 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Division 4 of Chapter 1, titled "Procurement from Businesses with
Drug-Free Workplace Program," of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Sections 1-71 through Section 1-73 of the Broward County Code of
Ordinances are hereby repealed in their entirety.

27 Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective
date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word
"ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or
phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such intention.
