1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; ADOPTING
3 THE 2024 BROWARD COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
4 PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 WHEREAS, Florida law requires every county to develop and maintain a
7 Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan ("CEMP");

8 WHEREAS, every four years, the applicable CEMP is subject to review by the
9 Florida Division of Emergency Management ("FDEM");

10 WHEREAS, the FDEM has completed its review of the proposed 2024 Broward
11 County CEMP and determined that it complies with the applicable requirements and
12 criteria; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable regulations, following the FDEM determination
14 that the proposed CEMP complies with the applicable requirements and criteria, the
15 governing body of the county must adopt the plan by resolution and provide to the FDEM
16 a copy of the resolution and the approved plan, NOW, THEREFORE,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
18 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:
