ORDINANCE NO.

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE BROWARD COUNTY COMMUNITY
3 REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY; REPEALING ARTICLE XV OF CHAPTER 1 AND
4 SECTIONS 1-292 THROUGH 1-298 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF
5 ORDINANCES ("CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE
6 CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity declared the
10 Broward County Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") inactive as of February 26, 2024; and

11 WHEREAS, consistent with applicable law, the Broward County Board of County
12 Commissioners finds it appropriate to repeal the provisions of the Broward County Code
13 of Ordinances relating to the inactive CRA,

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
15 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

16 Section 1. Article XV of Chapter 1 and Sections 1-292 through 1-298 of the
17 Broward County Code of Ordinances are hereby repealed in their entirety.

18 Section 2. Severability.

19 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
20 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
21 Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be

legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such intention.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
