OVERVIEW

THE EXPANDED COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF 12-MODEL

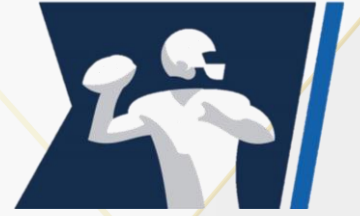
- In 2014-15, the inaugural College Football Playoff (CFP) four-team model began featuring the four best teams
- In December 2022, the CFP Board of Managers voted to expand the playoff to 12-team model beginning in the 2024-25 season
 - The four (4) first-round games will be played at campus sites
 - For the 2024-25 and 2025-26 seasons, the four (4) Quarterfinals and two (2) Semifinals will be rotated amongst the New Year's Six bowls:
 - ✓ Capital One Orange Bowl (South Florida)
 - ✓ Allstate Sugar Bowl (New Orleans, LA)
 - ✓ Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl (Atlanta, GA)
 - ✓ Vrbo Fiesta Bowl (Phoenix, AZ)
 - ✓ Goodyear Cotton Bowl (Dallas, TX)
 - ✓ Rose Bowl presented by Prudential (Pasadena, CA)
 - Currently working on next CFP agreement (2026-27 to 2031-32)

CFP NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BID PROCESS

- The prestigious CFP National Championship Game is not guaranteed but rather awarded to a different city through a bid process (e.g. Super Bowl, Olympics, World Cup and Final Four)

COLLEGE FOOTBALL AT LARGE

- College Football remains essentially tied with Major League Baseball as the second most popular sport in America
- 56% of all Americans ages 12+ are College Football fans – **155 million people**
- College Sports fans are 1.6 times more likely to have incomes higher than \$100K compared to the overall US population
- 48% of fans are female and make up more than half of social media followings in college sports
 - ✓ Economic spending power of Female Known Fan households is upward of \$530 billion per year

RECORD-BREAKING RATINGS

- College football on ESPN accounts for the top 15 and more than 50 of the top 100 most-watched cable programs on record (since 1987), with eight of the top 10 directly from Playoff Semifinals or national championship games.
- The 2015 title game between Ohio State and Oregon is the most-watched cable broadcast of all time, with more than 33,000,000 viewers. The 2018 game between Alabama and Clemson is the second most-watched broadcast of all time
- The 2023 College Football Playoff National Championship (featuring Michigan vs. Washington) peaked at 28 million viewers, ranking as a top 15 cable telecast all-time and the fourth-best non-NFL sports telecast since 2018
- College Football Playoff and New Year's Six bowl social media engagements grew to 4.9 million in 2023-24

ECONOMIC IMPACT

SOUTH FLORIDA CHAMPIONSHIP ECONOMIC IMPACT

- Rich tradition of hosting National Championship games delivering significant economic impact to the region
- Anticipate the economic impact of the 2026 CFPNCG will exceed the impact of previous National Championship games

Estimated Impact (based on previous Semifinal and Championship Game Studies)

- 2026 CFPNCG is projected to generate well over \$265 million in economic output and media value
- Over \$100 million in tremendous media exposure between Aug. 2025 – Jan. 2026
- Approximately 95 percent of attendees are estimated to live outside South Florida, staying an average of 3.8 nights

Hotel Occupancy Rates

- The 2026 College Football Playoff National Championship is projected to generate higher room rates and higher occupancy rates than those typically documented in the third week of January



COMMUNITY BENEFITS

BENEFIT TO THE SOUTH FLORIDA REGION

- South Florida has a rich tradition of hosting National Championship games, historically resulting in significant economic impact generation throughout the region.
- In addition to perpetuating South Florida's key role in postseason college football, the 2026 College Football Playoff National Championship Game is expected to generate hundreds of millions of dollars in economic impact for the region and provide tremendous media exposure.
- A robust series of events and experiences has been developed over the next two years and leading up to the title game on Monday night.

- Public and private support from the community is vital to the 2026 Host Committee's success and its ability to provide the maximum possible benefit to South Florida.

EXTRA YARD FOR TEACHERS

Innovation Learning Space Makeover Program

- The College Football Playoff Foundation, 2026 Host Committee and Orange Bowl Committee and Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) have agreed to a matching investment of up to \$500,000 for a total **\$1,000,000 investment** in ten (10) Broward County school media centers as part of our *Extra Yard for Teachers Innovation Learning Space Makeover Program*
 - Seven (7) Middle Schools - \$120,000 per school project
 - Three (3) Elementary Schools - \$40,000 per school project

BROWARD COUNTY HOST COMMITTEE STEM DAY

The 2026 Host Committee will host a Stem Day at a Broward County venue to complement the CFP Foundation initiative to enhance education.
