RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF
3 FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 FUNDS IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$20,823,637 TO
4 SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE PROVISION OF SUPPORT SERVICES
5 TO INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS IN BROWARD
6 COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE NEW
7 AGREEMENTS WITH THE SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS; AUTHORIZING THE
8 COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND
9 BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR
10 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
13 ("Board"), desires to appropriate and disburse funding to specified service providers for
14 the provision of support services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness
15 in Broward County for fiscal year 2026-2027 ("FY2027");

16 WHEREAS, the Board desires to authorize the Broward County Administrator
17 ("County Administrator") to execute, on behalf of Broward County, new agreements with
18 the service providers identified in Attachment A;

19 WHEREAS, the Board further desires to provide FY2027 funding for existing
20 agreements with the service providers identified in Attachment B upon renewal of those
21 agreements; and

22 WHEREAS, the Board finds that these services benefit the residents of Broward
23 County and serve a public purpose, NOW, THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
25 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

26 Section 1. The Board hereby authorizes appropriation and disbursement of
27 FY2027 funds in the aggregate amount of Twenty Million Eight Hundred Twenty-three
28 Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars (\$20,823,637) as set forth in Attachments A
29 and B.

30 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to execute new agreements,
31 in substantially the same form as the applicable Board-approved standard form
32 agreement, with the service providers identified with an "N" in Attachment A. Nothing in
33 this Resolution alters the requirement that agreements be reviewed and approved for
34 legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney before execution by the County
35 Administrator. Any material deviations from the applicable Board-approved form
36 agreement must be presented to the Board for approval.

37 Section 3. The agreements with the service providers identified with an "R" in
38 Attachment B will be renewed for FY2027 in accordance with the terms and conditions of
39 the agreements.

40 Section 4. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessary
41 administrative and budgetary actions to implement the agreements and the funding
42 allocations set forth in Attachments A and B.

Section 5. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
