## RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD  
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE DONATION FROM NOVA SOUTHEASTERN  
3 UNIVERSITY, INC., OF TWO HABITAT TANKS WITH AN ESTIMATED VALUE OF  
4 SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000); AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY  
5 ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS  
6 NECESSARY TO ACCEPT THE DONATION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY  
7 AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 WHEREAS, Nova Southeastern University, Inc. ("NSU"), wishes to donate, for use  
10 by the Broward County Parks and Recreation Division, two 370-gallon tanks that contain  
11 exhibits designed to represent different habitats seen in Florida;

12 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code requires  
13 that donations to Broward County valued at Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more be  
14 accepted by a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board"); and

15 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous donation from NSU, and to  
16 formally express its gratitude for the donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
18 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

19 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the generous donation of two habitat  
20 tanks, with an estimated combined value of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000), from NSU,  
21 whose address is 3300 South University Drive, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33328. On behalf

22 of the County and the residents and guests who utilize the Broward County parks system,  
23 the Board expresses its gratitude for the donation.

24 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative and  
25 budgetary actions and to execute any documentation necessary to accept the donation.

26 Section 3. Severability.

27 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid  
28 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this  
29 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be  
30 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such  
31 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,  
32 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

33 Section 4. Effective Date.

34 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
