1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; APPROVING
3 PROJECT MAVERICK FOR A BROWARD COUNTY STRATEGIC JOB CREATION
4 INCENTIVE PURSUANT TO SECTION 9½-52, BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF
5 ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF EIGHTY-ONE
6 THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$81,200) FOR A STRATEGIC JOB
7 CREATION INCENTIVE FOR FISCAL YEARS 2024 THROUGH 2032; AND PROVIDING
8 FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, the corporation referred to as Project Maverick, for the purpose of this
11 Resolution, has requested that Broward County maintain the confidentiality of its name
12 and business information pursuant to Section 288.075, Florida Statutes;

13 WHEREAS, Project Maverick, an international aviation company currently located
14 in the City of Miramar, is considering expanding its current operations in Broward County
15 by locating an international headquarters in the City of Miramar, Florida; and

16 WHEREAS, Project Maverick is requesting a Strategic Job Creation Incentive from
17 Broward County pursuant to Section 9½-52, Broward County Code of Ordinances, NOW,
18 THEREFORE,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
20 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

21 Section 1. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners (“Board”)
22 hereby approves a Strategic Job Creation Incentive not to exceed a total amount of
23 Eighty-One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$81,200) for fiscal years 2024 through 2032,
24 collectively, through Broward County’s Strategic Job Creation Incentive Program,
25 calculated on the basis of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700) per qualifying job.

26 Section 2. In furtherance of Project Maverick’s request for approval, the Board
27 has determined that the basis of this proposed project’s private sector wage commitment
28 calculation shall be one hundred fifteen percent (115%) of the average annual wage in
29 Broward County.

30 Section 3. The amounts authorized herein shall constitute Broward County’s
31 total commitment to this project for participation in the Strategic Job Creation Incentive
32 Program.

33 Section 4. The County Administrator is authorized to execute all necessary
34 documents in connection with the award and administration of the incentive, subject to
35 review and approval for legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney, provided
36 the County’s total financial commitment does not exceed the maximum amount stated
37 herein.

38 Section 5. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessary
39 administrative and budgetary actions to implement and administer the incentive award.

40 Section 6. Severability.

41 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
42 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
43 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
