AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO MOTOR CARRIERS; AMENDING CHAPTER 22½ OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE") TO UPDATE MINIMUM VEHICLE STANDARDS AND OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO TAXICABS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 22½ of the Broward County Code of Ordinances (the "Code") governs motor carrier operations within Broward County, including provisions establishing minimum vehicle standards for motor carriers and taxicabs;

WHEREAS, to protect public safety and promote efficient service, the County finds it appropriate to revise certain regulations within the Code relating to vehicle standards and taxicab operations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to amend the Code to update the minimum vehicle standards for motor carriers,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Sections 22½-6B, 22½-6D, 22½-9A, and 22½-9B of the Broward County Code of Ordinances are hereby amended to read as follows:
