RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE DONATION FROM PATRICIA LEAZIER OF
3 VELODROME RESURFACING GOODS AND SERVICES AT BRIAN PICCOLO
4 SPORTS PARK WITH AN ESTIMATED VALUE OF ONE HUNDRED ELEVEN
5 THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$111,174); AUTHORIZING
6 THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY
7 ACTIONS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT THE DONATION; AND PROVIDING FOR
8 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, Patricia Leazier wishes to donate goods and services to resurface the
11 track at the Velodrome at Brian Piccolo Sports Park and Velodrome (the "Park");

12 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code requires
13 that donations to Broward County valued at Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more be
14 accepted by a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board"); and

15 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous donation from Patricia
16 Leazier, and to formally express its gratitude for the donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
18 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

19 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the generous donation of goods and
20 services to resurface the Velodrome Track at the Park, with an estimated value of One
21 Hundred Eleven Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars (\$111,174) from Patricia

Leazier, 900 West Branch Street, Lantana, Florida, 33462. On behalf of the County and the residents and guest who utilize the Park, the Board expresses its gratitude for the donation.

Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative and budgetary actions and to execute any documentation necessary to accept the donation.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
