## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR WRITTEN DESIGNEE TO SIGN AND EXECUTE A PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT AGREEMENT (PTGA) WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT), DISTRICT 4, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE INTERSTATE 95 (I-95) EXPRESS BUS SERVICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,921,360; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR WRITTEN DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR WRITTEN DESIGNEE TO SIGN ANY FUTURE AMENDMENTS EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THIS PTGA THAT DO NOT POSE ADDITIONAL COST OR MATERIAL RISK TO THE COUNTY, SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND OTHER DOCUMENTATION FOR LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, Section 341.041, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to provide funding for public transit and intercity bus service programs;

WHEREAS, Broward County is a recipient of the Transit Corridor Development Program for the Operation and Maintenance of the Interstate 95 (I-95) Express Bus Service grant funds; and

WHEREAS, FDOT has allocated Two Million Nine Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$2,921,360) for operations and maintenance of the I-95 Express Bus Service grant funds to reduce time travel, increase service reliability and provide Broward County and Miami Dade County commuters with efficient travel options, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida (the "Board"), authorizes its County Administrator, or written designee, to sign and to execute the Public Transportation Grant Agreement ("PTGA") with FDOT, District 4, attached as Exhibit 1, for a total project cost of Two Million Nine Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$2,921,360) in State Fiscal Year 2026 that provides funding for public transit and intercity bus service programs, granted under Financial Project No. 424219-4-84-011.

Section 2. The Board authorizes the County Administrator to take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement the PTGA.
