This exhibit provides a comparative overview of Foreign-Trade Zone (“FTZ”) application, activation, annual operator, and deactivation fees for FTZ No. 25 (current and proposed) and selected peer FTZ programs in South Florida, for informational purposes in support of the proposed revisions to Port Everglades FTZ No. 25, Tariff No. 5.
