1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE INCLUSION OF THREE PROJECTS UNDER
3 BROWARD COUNTY'S JURISDICTION IN THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN
4 PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S AMENDED 2050 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION
5 PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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7 WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") approved
8 the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan on December 12, 2024;

9 WHEREAS, the MPO is seeking to amend the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation
10 Plan to include the following three projects as part of the MPO's Transportation
11 Improvement Program: the NW 31st Avenue Safety Improvement Project, from Broward
12 Boulevard to McNab Road; the NW 19th Street Safety Improvement Project, from
13 NW 43rd Terrace to NW 31st Avenue; and the West Broward Boulevard Safety
14 Improvement Project, from Central Park Drive to University Drive;

15 WHEREAS, the MPO requires a resolution of support from the Broward County
16 Board of County Commissioners ("Board") to include the three projects under Broward
17 County's jurisdiction in the amended 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan; and

18 WHEREAS, Broward County commits to working with the MPO, transportation
19 partners, and the public to prepare the projects for programming in the MPO's
20 Transportation Improvement Program, NOW, THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
22 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

23 Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are true and correct and are
24 hereby made a part of this Resolution.

25 Section 2. The Board supports the inclusion of the NW 31st Avenue Safety
26 Improvement Project, from Broward Boulevard to McNab Road; the NW 19th Street
27 Safety Improvement Project, from NW 43rd Terrace to NW 31st Avenue; and the West
28 Broward Boulevard Safety Improvement Project, from Central Park Drive to University
29 Drive, in the MPO's amended 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan to improve roadway
30 safety conditions for all users, including drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians.

31 Section 3. Severability.

32 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
33 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
34 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
35 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
36 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
37 group, entity, property, or circumstance.
