MOTION STATEMENT:

MOTION TO DIRECT and authorize County Administration, in consultation with the County Attorney's Office, to take all actions necessary with respect to County administrative and operational rules, regulations, programs, and policies to timely comply with Senate Bill 1134 (2026) **and/or House Bill 1217 (2026)**, including any necessary budgetary and administrative actions; and to direct and authorize the County Administrator, in consultation with the County Attorney's Office, to negotiate and execute amendments to County contracts at no additional cost to the County to the extent necessary to timely comply with Senate Bill 1134 (2026) **and/or House Bill 1217 (2026)**, subject to review and approval for legal sufficiency by the County Attorney's Office.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 1134 (2026) ("SB 1134"), as enacted by the Florida Legislature, becomes effective January 1, 2027. SB 1134 generally prohibits local governments from funding or promoting or taking any official action related to diversity, equity, or inclusion, as defined by Section 125.595, Florida Statutes.

House Bill 1217 (2026) ("HB 1217"), as enacted by the Florida Legislature, becomes effective July 1, 2026. HB 1217 generally prohibits use of public funds to support, implement, or advance a net zero policy, as defined by Section 377.816, Florida Statutes.

This agenda item provides appropriate direction and authority to County Administration to take all actions necessary to timely comply with SB 1134 **and/or HB 1217**, including any necessary changes to County administrative and operational rules, regulations, programs, and policies, and any necessary amendments to County contracts. The ~~January 1, 2027, effective date enables the~~ County Administrator to **will** provide prior notice to the County Commission before taking any action to modify a rule, regulation, program, or policy that was approved by the Commission or that would impose a material financial cost to the County not included in the applicable approved Fiscal Year budget.
