RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE DESIGNATION OF THE BRIDGE ON STATE ROAD 7 OVER SAMPLE ROAD AS THE “SPC DANIEL J. AGAMI BRIDGE”; RECOGNIZING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HONORARY DESIGNATION MARKERS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida House Bill 987 (2025), which was approved by Governor Ron DeSantis on June 13, 2025, provides for the designation of the bridge on State Road 7 over Sample Road as the “SPC Daniel J. Agami Bridge” in recognition of U.S. Army Specialist (“SPC”) Daniel J. Agami of Coconut Creek, Florida, who died while serving in Baghdad as a result of injuries suffered after explosion of an improvised explosive device;

WHEREAS, SPC Daniel J. Agami earned numerous decorations as a result of his military service in the United States Army, including a Purple Heart and a Bronze Star, and was reportedly known among his fellow soldiers for his commitment to his Jewish faith; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation will be responsible for the placement and maintenance of appropriate markers to designate the bridge in honor of SPC Daniel J. Agami, NOW, THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

23 Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
24 ("Board"), hereby formally supports the honorary designation of the bridge on State
25 Road 7 over Sample Road as the "SPC Daniel J. Agami Bridge."

26 Section 2. The Board recognizes the Florida Department of Transportation as
27 the agency responsible for the placement and maintenance of the honorary designation
28 markers.

29 Section 3. Severability.

30 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
31 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
32 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
33 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
34 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
35 group, entity, property, or circumstance.
