

**PARTICIPATING ADDENDUM BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND  
NATIONS BUS CORPORATION  
PURSUANT TO FDOT AGREEMENT NO. TRIPS-22-CA-MB-LF-NBC**

This Participating Addendum (“Addendum”) is between Broward County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (“County” or “Purchaser”), and Nations Bus Corporation (“Contractor”) (each a “Party” and collectively referred to as the “Parties”).

RECITALS

A. On July 28, 2023, the Florida Department of Transportation, a State of Florida government agency, entered into Contract No. TRIPS-22-CA-MB-LF-NBC with Contractor for the purchase of standard cutaway and minibus chassis type transit vehicles (the “FDOT Agreement”).

B. Section 21.27 of the Broward County Procurement Code authorizes County to purchase goods under a procurement contract held by another governmental entity that was competitively procured. County has obtained written authorization from FDOT to utilize the FDOT Agreement. County desires to purchase 54 standard cutaway and minibus chassis type transit vehicles under the FDOT Agreement.

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

**1. DEFINITIONS**

Except as expressly provided in this Addendum, all defined terms in the FDOT Agreement shall have the meanings set forth therein when used in this Addendum. All exhibits referenced in this Addendum are incorporated into and made part of this Addendum by reference. In addition, the following terms have the stated meanings:

1.1. **Contract Administrator** means County’s Transportation Department Director, County’s Transportation Department Assistant General Manager of Operations, or such other individual designated in writing by the same.

1.2. **Purchaser** or **FDOT** means County for purposes of this Addendum and for all transactions between County and Contractor pursuant to the FDOT Agreement. For clarity, as it relates to the relationship between County and Contractor pursuant to this Addendum, all references to the Purchaser or any reference that is intended in context to refer to the purchasing entity shall be deemed to refer to Broward County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (or, as applicable, to the respective Broward County entity or agency).

**2. INCORPORATION OF EXHIBITS**

2.1. The Florida Department of Transportation Contract No. TRIPS-22-CA-MB-LF-NBC, by and between the Florida Department of Transportation and Nations Bus Corporation, together with

all exhibits incorporated therein (the "FDOT Agreement"), is attached as Exhibit A and is incorporated by reference, as applicable to the County's purchases under this Addendum.

2.2. Correspondence from the Florida Department of Transportation authorizing the County to utilize the FDOT Agreement, including FDOT's letter dated October 28, 2025, is attached as Exhibit B and is incorporated by reference for the limited purpose of evidencing such authorization.

2.3. The pricing applicable to County's purchases under this Addendum, as reflected in the FDOT Agreement and any applicable Order Packet, is attached as Exhibit C and is incorporated by reference.

2.4. The insurance requirements applicable to this Addendum, including Broward County's standard insurance provisions, are attached as Exhibit D and are incorporated by reference.

### **3. OTHER TERMS**

3.1. Purchase and Provision of Goods. Contractor agrees to provide County with vehicles for purchase under the same terms as the FDOT Agreement (collectively, "Goods"), which County may from time to time order, in accordance with the terms of the FDOT Agreement, as modified by this Addendum.

3.2. Term. This Addendum shall be effective upon complete execution of this Addendum (the "Effective Date") and shall expire on the earlier of the expiration of the FDOT Agreement or July 28, 2028 ("Term"), unless terminated earlier pursuant to this Addendum.

3.3. Fiscal Year. The continuation of this Addendum beyond the end of any County fiscal year (October 1 through September 30) shall be subject to both the appropriation and the availability of transportation surtax funds, in accordance with Chapter 129, Florida Statutes and, if applicable, Chapter 212, Florida Statutes. In addition, funding provided by County to Contractor for Goods that will be paid for with proceeds from the transportation surtax levied pursuant to Section 212.055(1), Florida Statutes, is subject to both the appropriation and the availability of transportation surtax funds. County shall not have any obligation to provide nor shall County provide any funding for such Goods from County's general revenue or any other County source other than the transportation surtax.

3.4. Maximum Amounts. County may procure Goods under this Addendum during the Term up to the maximum amount of Ten Million Nine Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$10,985,490).

3.5. Warranty; Liquidated Damages; Insurance. In accordance with Section I.7 (Warranty) of the General Requirements and Conditions, Contractual Provisions of the FDOT Agreement, and Exhibit 1, Part 4 (Warranty Provisions) thereto, Contractor unconditionally guarantees the materials and workmanship on all equipment and Goods furnished under this Addendum for the durations and subject to the terms set forth in the FDOT Agreement. If, within the applicable warranty period, any defects or signs of deterioration are noted by County which, in the opinion

of County, are due to faulty design, installation, workmanship, or materials, Contractor, upon written notice and at its expense, shall repair or adjust the equipment or parts to correct the condition, or replace the defective part or entire unit, all in accordance with the warranty procedures set forth in the FDOT Agreement. Repairs, replacements, or adjustments will be performed at times designated by County so as to be least detrimental to County's operations. The liquidated damages provisions set forth in Section IV (Liquidated Damages) of the FDOT Agreement apply to delays in delivery as provided therein. If Contractor fails to perform warranty repairs within the timeframes required under Exhibit 1, Part 4 of the FDOT Agreement, and such failure results in warranted equipment being out of service for more than ten consecutive calendar days after written notice, County may assess liquidated damages in the same per-day amount specified in Section IV of the FDOT Agreement until the equipment is restored to service. Contractor shall comply with the insurance requirements set forth in the Minimum Insurance Requirements attached as Exhibit D to this Addendum.

3.6. Indemnification. Contractor shall indemnify, hold harmless, and defend County and all of County's current, past, and future officers, agents, and employees (collectively, "Indemnified Party") from and against any and all causes of action, demands, claims, losses, liabilities, and expenditures of any kind, including attorneys' fees, court costs, and expenses, including through the conclusion of any appellate proceedings, raised or asserted by any person or entity not a party to this Addendum, and caused or alleged to be caused, in whole or in part, by any breach of this Addendum by Contractor, or any intentional, reckless, or negligent act or omission of Contractor, its officers, employees, or agents, arising from, relating to, or in connection with this Addendum (collectively, a "Claim"). If any Claim is brought against an Indemnified Party, Contractor shall, upon written notice from County, defend each Indemnified Party with counsel satisfactory to County or, at County's option, pay for an attorney selected by the County Attorney to defend the Indemnified Party. The obligations of this section shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this Addendum. If considered necessary by the Contract Administrator and the County Attorney, any sums due Contractor under this Addendum may be retained by County until all Claims subject to this indemnification obligation have been settled or otherwise resolved. Any amount withheld shall not be subject to payment of interest by County.

3.7. Florida Statutory Required Provisions. Except to the extent sovereign immunity may be deemed waived by entering into this Addendum, nothing herein is intended to serve as a waiver of sovereign immunity by Broward County. Contractor warrants and represents the following: it has not been placed on the "discriminatory vendor list" as provided in Section 287.134, Florida Statutes; it is not a "scrutinized company" pursuant to Sections 215.473 or 215.4725, Florida Statutes; it is not, and for the duration of the Addendum will not be, ineligible to contract with County on any of the grounds stated in Section 287.135, Florida Statutes; it is, and for the duration of the term will remain, in compliance with Section 286.101, Florida Statutes; it has registered with and uses the E-Verify system maintained by the United States Department of Homeland Security to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees in compliance with the requirements of Section 448.095, Florida Statutes; it is not owned by the government of a foreign country of concern; the government of a foreign country of concern does not have a controlling interest in Contractor; it is not organized under the laws of and does

not have its principal place of business in, a foreign country of concern; and it does not use coercion for labor or services, as such terms are defined in Section 787.06, Florida Statutes. By signature below, Contractor by its duly authorized representative declares the foregoing under penalty of perjury in compliance with Section 287.138(4), Florida Statutes.

3.8. Public Records. Notwithstanding any other provision in this Addendum, any action taken by County in compliance with, or in a good faith attempt to comply with, the requirements of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, shall not constitute a breach of this Addendum. To the extent applicable, the provisions of Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, are incorporated as if fully restated herein.

3.9. Notices. In order for a notice to a Party to be effective under this Addendum, notice must be sent via U.S. first-class mail, hand delivery, or commercial overnight delivery, each with a contemporaneous copy via e-mail, to the addresses listed below and shall be effective upon mailing or hand delivery (provided the contemporaneous email is also sent). The addresses for notice shall remain as set forth herein unless and until changed by providing notice of such change.

3.10. Law, Jurisdiction, Venue, Waiver of Jury Trial. Purchases made under this Addendum, and the relationship between Contractor and County, shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of the State of Florida. The exclusive venue for any lawsuit between the Parties arising from, related to, or in connection with this Addendum shall be in the state courts of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit in and for Broward County, Florida. If any claim arising from, related to, or in connection with this Addendum must be litigated in federal court, the exclusive venue for any such lawsuit shall be in the United States District Court or United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Florida. **EACH PARTY HEREBY**

**EXPRESSLY WAIVES ANY RIGHTS IT MAY HAVE TO A TRIAL BY JURY OF ANY CIVIL LITIGATION RELATED TO THIS ADDENDUM.**


