SECTION 5339, BUS AND BUS FACILITIES FORMULA GRANTS, IN THE 8 AMOUNT OF \$3,215,218 UNDER THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ACT; AUTHORIZING THE 9 DIRECTOR OF THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO FURNISH THE FTA WITH 10 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AN AWARD AND TO SIGN ANY AND ALL 11 12 DOCUMENTATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRANT 13 APPLICATION OR AWARD, SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND APPROVAL FOR LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY; AUTHORIZING THE 14 COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY 15 16 ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 17

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal
 Transit Administration ("FTA") is authorized to make grants for transit projects; and
 WHEREAS, the FTA allocated Three Million Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Two
 Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$3,215,218) in 49 U.S.C. Section 5339, Bus and Bus Facilities

Formula Grant funds to Broward County, Florida, to assist in the purchase of buses and
related equipment, as well as the construction of bus-related facilities, NOW,
THEREFORE,

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 27 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Director of the Transportation Department is authorized to sign and submit a grant application to the FTA pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 5339 of the Federal Transit Act, for Fiscal Year 2023 Bus and Bus Facilities Formula Grant funds, in the amount of Three Million Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$3,215,218), to be appropriated as follows:
