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2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE  
5 BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION  
6 ("MPO") SEEKING GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE MPO'S  
7 COMPLETE STREETS AND OTHER LOCALIZED  
8 INITIATIVES PROGRAM FOR RAISED MEDIANS AND  
9 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON DAVIE  
10 BOULEVARD EXTENSION AND PETERS ROAD FROM  
11 SW 51<sup>st</sup> AVENUE TO WEST OF STATE ROAD 7; AND  
12 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE  
13 DATE.

14 WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has grant  
15 funds under its Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program ("Complete  
16 Streets") to construct raised medians and pedestrian facilities on roads off the state  
17 highway system; and

18 WHEREAS, Broward County ("County") intends to submit a grant application to  
19 the MPO seeking grant funds under the MPO's grant program in an amount up to Two  
20 Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) for raised medians, milling and resurfacing, and pedestrian  
21 safety improvements to the Davie Boulevard Extension and Peters Road between SW  
22 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue and State Road 7 (the "Project"); and

23 WHEREAS, Davie Boulevard and Peters Road are County roads in the Broward  
24 Municipal Services District ("BMSD") and in the City of Plantation; and

WHEREAS, the County is the owner of the road right-of-way for the Project and  
is committed to continue funding the operation and maintenance of Davie Boulevard  
Extension and Peters Road; and

1           WHEREAS, the Project will further the County's Complete Streets efforts while  
2 furthering the County's goal to support the development, design, and construction of  
3 sustainable, multimodal transportation facilities throughout the County, to meet the  
4 demands of residents, travelers, businesses, and the community; and

5           WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") will be  
6 the agency responsible for design and construction of the Project; and

7           WHEREAS, the Project shall be designed and constructed to meet the "Minimum  
8 Standards Applicable to Public Rights-of-Way Under Broward County Jurisdiction,"  
9 Chapter 25 of the Broward County Administrative Code; and

10           WHEREAS, the Project plans shall be submitted for review and approval to the  
11 Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division, NOW, THEREFORE,  
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13           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
14 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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16           Section 1.    The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed  
17 as being true and correct, and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

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19           Section 2.   The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida,  
20 ("Board") supports the County's application for grant funds through the MPO's Complete  
21 Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program.  
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23           Section 3.   The Board supports FDOT as the project designer and construction  
24 administrator.

1 Section 4. SEVERABILITY.

2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the  
3 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the  
4 remainder of this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any  
5 portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies),  
6 property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability  
7 hereof to any other individual group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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9 Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
