WHEREAS, Davie Boulevard and Peters Road are County roads in the Broward Municipal Services District ("BMSD") and in the City of Plantation; and

WHEREAS, the County is the owner of the road right-of-way for the Project and is committed to continue funding the operation and maintenance of Davie Boulevard Extension and Peters Road; and
